Dear Parents/carers,

Girls' Football Club, Autumn 2– Fridays: 3pm – 4.15pm

I am delighted to be able to inform you that Miss Smith's Solent Girls' Football Club shall be returning, starting from Friday 3rd November. The football club shall take place every Friday on the bottom playground at school until Friday 15th December, which will be the last session of the Autumn term, with the possibility it will return later in the academic year, likely in the summer term. **However, there is one Friday date within this block of Fridays where there will be no girls' football practice due to INSET Day on 17th November.**

If your daughter does not have a P.E lesson on a Friday, then she should ensure she brings in her kit so that she can get changed after school. The girls should also have their own shin pads and long socks to wear.

At the end of the club, I (Miss Smith) will escort the children up to the area by the school reception to be met by the person collecting them. As the evenings are dark early in the winter, children will not be able to walk home alone and so must be met by an agreed adult.
