Supporting Your Child in Reading

Dear Parents and Carers

After Easter, your child will be coming home with a new colour banded 'Real Book' to read, with the hope and expectation that these new books will foster a love of reading and be a way for families to enjoy reading for pleasure at home. So why not come along and join us for a workshop to:

- Look at what the research says about reading and its importance
- Understand the importance of fluency and how you can build this at home
- Have a clear understanding of reading strategies used at school
- Give hints and tips of how to get your child reading at home

The workshop groups for this session will be split into Years 3 & 4 and Years 5 & 6 (both based at SJS). Pupils will come into school normally and then those parents and carers who are attending will need to sign in via the school office. At 09:20 am, after a welcome and introduction to strategies to support reading from school staff, your child will join you for twenty minutes, along with a reading book, so that you can both then try these strategies out together in a supportive environment. To conclude the session, Mrs Young will introduce to you all our new wellbeing curriculum called 'Trick Box'.
