## Autumn Term

# Spring Term

As part of one of our writing units in Spring, we explore the story of Wonder and empathise with the character of August. We would like to show the PG rated 2017 film 'Wonder' before we break up for Easter.

For our cross-curricular topic, 'Putting on the Blitz', we use the BBC adaptation 'The Diary of Anne Frank'. We show the children Episodes 1,2,3 & 5 and they have been reviewed by teachers to ensure the content is appropriate. Linked to our history topic, watching this will give the children the opportunity to empathise with those affected by World War 2 and also, create a piece of writing in their English learning from the perspective of the Frank family.

During this term we would also like to watch "Goodnight Mr Tom" which is a PG.
