### **Year 6 SATS Meeting**

We would like to invite you to attend the **Year 6 SATs preparation meeting on Monday 2<sup>nd</sup> February 2026 at 4pm in 6P's classroom.**







As you may be aware, in the Summer Term children in Year 6 will take the SATs (Standard Attainment Tests). These tests in English and Maths will reflect the Revised National Curriculum and are more rigorous and even more challenging than in previous years. This is also reflected in the more challenging mark scheme that has replaced the old curriculum levels.

Year 6 children will sit tests in:

-  Reading
-  Maths
-  Spelling, grammar, punctuation and vocabulary.

**The Year 6 KS2 SATs will be carried out in school during the week commencing Monday 11<sup>th</sup> May 2026.**

To fully prepare you and your child for the experience of SATs, we invite you to meet with us so that we can:

-  Explain what 'SATs' are.
-  Talk through 'SATS' week and what will happen.
-  Share what the tests may include and the types of questions the children will need to be able to answer.
-  Explain how we can best prepare the children for this in school.
-  Share ideas and tips for how you can help your child at home.
-  Answer questions and concerns that you may have.

There are revision guides available. These guides are optional. A sample of the revision guides will be available at the presentation; however, we understand that some parents and carers will want to order these as soon as possible. For the revision guides, we are able to place one school order, on your behalf for the revision guides. Through school you can buy individual books at a cost of £4.00 per book or a bundle of all 6 books at a cost of £20.00. However, if you wish to source your own guides you can do so by using the Rising Stars website – Achieve 100 series.

To place an order through the school, please visit the shop section on the Arbor app, and pay for the items you require no later than **Sunday 8<sup>th</sup> February**. If we have not received your order and payment by this date unfortunately you will need to source your own guides as this will be the only order school will be placing. The order will be placed on Monday 10<sup>th</sup> February and books given to children once they have been received at school.

We are very proud of all the children and their achievements at Solent Junior, and we obviously want our Year 6s to be as successful as possible and do as well as they possibly can, by us all working together.
