**Girls' Football Club (All year groups)**

**Girls' Football Club, Spring 2 (with external provider) – Thursdays: 3pm – 4pm (26.02.26 – 26.03.26)**

**Girls' Football club, Summer 1 (with Miss Smith) – Fridays: 3pm – 4pm (17.4.26 – 22.05.2026)**

We are delighted to be able to inform you that a girls' football club will be returning this year. There are two opportunities (Spring 2 with an external provider) and (Summer 1 with Miss Smith). Both opportunities are free of charge and children can sign up for both or just one of these clubs.

**Spring 2:** The football club shall take place every **Thursday** on the bottom playground at school from 3pm until 4pm, with a total of 5 sessions.

**Summer 1:** The football club shall take place every **Friday** on the bottom playground at school from 3pm until 4pm, with a total of 6 sessions.

If your daughter does not have a P.E lesson on the day of the club, then she should ensure she brings in her kit so that she can get changed after school. The girls should also have their own shin pads and long socks to wear. The girls will meet in 6P (Miss Palmer's classroom) at the end of the day.

At the end of the club, the children will be escorted up to the area by the school reception to be met by the person collecting them. Lower School children (Years 3 & 4) will not be able to walk home alone and so must be met by an agreed adult. Upper School children (Years 5 & 6) are allowed to walk home, if they usually do.

For the Spring 2 club, there will be a total of 16 places available. For the Summer 1 more spaces are available with a total of 30.

To book your child a place at the girls' football clubs, please visit the Clubs Section on the Arbor app. Places will be allocated on a first come, first serve basis.

**Absence/cancellation:**

Your child's safety is of the upmost importance to us. Therefore, it is vital that you telephone the school office by 1:30pm if your child is unable to attend on that day. Please note, repeated failure to advise of your child's absence could compromise your child's place on the club. Thank you for your understanding and co-operation. Should the club need to be cancelled, due to weather, then you will receive a message by 1.30pm on that day.
