**Year 6 Day Trip
Paultons Park Friday 19th July 2024**

We would like to take this opportunity to celebrate with our fantastic Year 6 children, after the all the uncertainty of the past year and before they venture off to senior school. We would like Year 6 to spend a day out with their teachers and their fellow classmates at Paultons Park on **Friday 19th July 2024**. The coaches will be leaving Solent Junior School at 9:00am and are scheduled to leave Paultons Park at 2.00pm to return to school for approximately 3.00pm. Children will be expected to arrive at school at normal time for registration.

The children will need to bring a snack, a packed lunch and non-fizzy drinks. **Children eligible for free school meals will be provided with a packed lunch if they wish, please contact the school office no later than midday on Friday 5th July 2024 if you wish your free school meal child to have one.** If your child is likely to suffer from travel sickness they will need to take medication before school starts and have medication for the return journey. Please collect a form from the school office for completion and then ask your child to hand this form and the medication to their class teacher the morning of the trip.

On the day, children will need to:

- Wear suitable footwear (e.g., trainers)
- Wear sensible, comfortable non-uniform (e.g. jeans, t-shirt, hoodie)
- Bring sun cream and a hat
- Take a waterproof jacket or coat
- Take a full water bottle
- Snacks (non-allergy items)

The children also need to be aware that they will be carrying their bags at all times, so the lighter and smaller the bag, the better. Paulton's Park remains a cashless attraction and is only accepting credit cards for items such as ice creams etc, so due to this there is no reason for your child to bring any money on this trip.

We are asking for a payment of £ 27.00 per child. If you would like your child to take part please make payment using the School Gateway app. To secure your child a place please pay by **Friday 5th July 2024** at the latest.

Behaviour

If that is deemed the case we will have no option but either invite their parent/carer to supervise their own child on the visit or withdraw their invite.

As I am sure you can appreciate, we do not and will not make decisions lightly. If your child is displaying behaviour that puts them at risk of missing out on the visit, we will contact you immediately and open a dialogue regarding possible outcomes; we value all parents, carers and pupils' support in this matter.
