Dear Parents and Carers,

**Year 5 Stubbington Study Centre Residential - Monday 3<sup>rd</sup> March – Friday 7<sup>th</sup> March 2025**

Further to our previous letter and meeting we can now let you know that the anticipated cost of this trip will be £270.00. An initial, **non-refundable deposit of £50 must be received by Friday 6<sup>th</sup> September 2024. If you have already paid the deposit this will be moved over to the new system, Arbor.** Payment can be made online from Tuesday 3<sup>rd</sup> September using the new Arbor app, unfortunately we are not able to accept payment in cash. **Please note that if you do not pay the deposit by this date, we cannot guarantee your child a space at a later date.**

We shall write to you again when we have final numbers, to confirm the final cost of the trip and implement a payment plan to enable you to spread the balance over 5 monthly payments (these will be due on 1<sup>st</sup> October, 1<sup>st</sup> November, 1<sup>st</sup> December 2024, 1<sup>st</sup> January and 1<sup>st</sup> February 2025).

**Parent Volunteers:**

Over the last couple of terms, we have been incredibly fortunate and have had a high number of parents/carers sign up to volunteer in school, and this included residential support. If you would like the opportunity to accompany the children on the residential then please complete the volunteer JotForm by clicking the link [HERE](#). The school will also need to carry out a DBS check which can take up to 6 weeks, as well as an induction process, so please register your interest as soon as possible to ensure that you would be able to attend. In return for volunteering, parents will be provided with three generous meals a day, plus snacks, hot and cold drinks. If you wish, you are also able to join in with all the activities.

Alongside a qualified Stubbington instructor, volunteers will supervise a group of Year 5 children. Responsibilities will include taking children to and from activities, to the cafeteria for meals, and ensuring children are ready for bed on time! At all times, class teachers will be available to support and assist.
