Dear Parents and Carers,

Year 5 Winchester Science Centre – Tuesday 8th October 2024

We are delighted to offer your child a space on our upcoming Year 5 Day Trip to the Winchester Science Centre, on Tuesday 8th October 2024. This trip will be incredibly beneficial towards the pupils Year 5 learning journey as we will be exploring Earth and Space within our Science curriculum and Planet Information Text within our English lessons.

In order to make this trip as successful as possible there are a number of costs involved: entry to the Science Museum and the cost of the coaches. To reserve a place for your child on this trip we are asking for a contribution of £26.50, this can be made online using the new Arbor app. We have tried to keep the cost as low as possible, choosing to travel to the event on the school minibus. If we do not receive sufficient funds, the trip will have to be cancelled. We have tried to keep the cost as low as possible, choosing somewhere that has a low entry cost but we appreciate that the cost of this trip may be high for some families.

Our visit will include: time to look around and investigate the hands-on exhibits; take part in a 'Destination Space' workshop; and experience the 'Solar System and Beyond' in a Planetarium show. The coaches will be leaving Solent Junior School at 9:00am and are scheduled to leave Winchester Science Centre at 2:00pm to return to school for approximately 3:00pm. Children will be expected to arrive at school at normal time for registration.

On the day, children will need to:

1. Wear smart school uniform
2. Bring a full water bottle and an optional healthy snack (both named)
3. Lunch (see notes below)

Lunch will need to be **disposable**, and in a **named carrier bag** please, which will be stored in the Centre's dedicated Star Room. If you would like to order a picnic bag for the visit then please contact the school office. **These must be ordered by 9am on Friday 27th September at the latest.** The children also need to be aware that they will be carrying all other belongings at all times. Large rucksacks are not advised.

If your child is likely to suffer from travel sickness they will need to take medication before school starts and have medication with them in a named packet for the return journey, this will need to be handed to their teacher on arrival at school. Children will **not** have the opportunity to visit the shop and so we ask that no money be brought on this trip. Mobile phones will also be left at school as per normal school procedure.

If you have previously helped us out as a volunteer and would like to attend the trip to support our pupils, please would you kindly let Mrs Colarusso and/or the office team know.
