The teacher will share lots of very useful information to guide you in supporting your child within their new year group for example:

- Curriculum and Academic expectations.
- Phonics and Spelling.
- The teaching of Maths in their year group.
- A walk through the website and useful information for the year group.
- How to access support from school.
- Organisational features of your new class (PE days, timetables, library etc.)

For those that are starting in Year 3, the meeting dates remain the same as those that have already been shared at previous meetings. These are held in the school hall with the Head of School and Year 3 teachers.
