On the date when your child's year group has been invited in early, we would ask that you bring them to the school office, where they will be met by Mrs Bannister-Palmer. We will then sign them in to school, so we know they are present. During the time the gates are open, the children will then visit roads around either the infant or junior school. By sending the children in, you will be agreeing to them being off site for this time. They will then be returned to school at the time the registration is taken.

If your child has been invited to stay after school, they will be collected from their class and then supervised in the same way by Mrs Bannister-Palmer. We will then return to the school office at 3.30pm, where you can either collect your child if in the lower school, or, in the upper school they will be dismissed to walk home; if they attend an after-school club they will be taken there.

The work of the Junior Road Safety Officers will feature in whole school assemblies and also the newsletter so you will be kept updated about all of their amazing work and initiatives.
