YEAR 4 RESIDENTIAL VISIT TO CALSHOT ACTIVITY CENTRE

Monday 1st December – Wednesday 3rd December 2025

Our Year 4 residential trip to Calshot is approaching. Below is an important email containing lots of useful information about the upcoming trip.

Information:

On Monday 1st December, we will be leaving after registration, so <u>children will need to arrive for school at the usual school time.</u> Upon arrival at school on the day of the trip, children will need to neatly line up their suitcases/bags outside their classroom. Children will be expected to carry all their own luggage. **All luggage should also be labelled.**

On Monday 1st December, the children will be required to bring a packed lunch for their lunch. Please make sure the packed lunch is fully disposable as there will be no facilities to wash up any containers. From the evening of Monday 1st December until lunchtime on Wednesday 3rd December, all other meals and snacks will be provided by Calshot.

<u>We will return on Wednesday 3rd December</u>; collection of your children will be as usual at the normal end of the school day.

As it will be the start of December, the temperature is expected to be cold, so please ensure your children have plenty of warm clothes.

<u>Check List</u>: (Please make sure everything is labelled clearly with your child's name)

This year, Calshot have requested that the children bring a single fitted sheet, a single duvet and cover or a sleeping bag, a pillow and pillowcase. No bedding will be provided to the children by Calshot.

Long sleeved top for skiing
Spare underwear (including long thick socks for skiing)
A warm coat (perhaps a light waterproof too)

<u>Children are not permitted to bring in any electronic items, food or games. This includes kindles, tablets, mobile phones and Tonie/Yoto boxes.</u>

Medication must be clearly labelled with your child's name, class and set of instructions on how to administer (medical consent form from the school office). Please give this to class teacher on the morning of the trip.
