Dear Parents and Carers.

Year 5 Educational Visit to Stubbington Study Centre Monday 2nd March – Friday 6th March 2026

Parents / Adults Information Meeting

You are all invited to join us on **Wednesday 14th January 2026 at 3.30pm to 4.00pm, in class 5CB**. During this time, we intend on providing parents and carers with all the information you need regarding the residential.

Medical Forms

To support organising this trip, we enclose the attached consent and medical form for you to complete and return to school as soon as possible. (NO child may take part in this trip unless we have this information). Please complete by Wednesday 14th January 2026 to support us to complete them in time for the date requestion by Stubbington.

If you child requires medicine whilst we are away, including travel sickness tablets, please complete the specific medicine form and bring it named with the medicine on the day of the trip.

Dietary Needs

Whilst we are at Stubbington, special diets can be arranged. Therefore, would you please let us know, in writing, of any specific dietary requirements your child may have. We do require this information by **Wednesday 14**th **January 2026.** Furthermore, should your child have any additional dietary needs, please highlight this again at the top of the form in BOLD writing please, e.g. vegetarian, this will enable us and the Stubbington team to ensure that the child must follow that diet for the duration of the visit.

Within the parent/carer information pack is the kit list for the visit and a required clothing list for specific activities, please make sure you read through these lists before packing your child's case and LABEL ALL

ITEMS! Activities will continue to take place in the rain, so light, waterproof clothing is essential. The children also need shoes that are comfortable for walking in, it is best if the shoes are old and can be thrown away after use.

All luggage should be packed into ONE small suitcase/holdall (which your child will have to carry themselves). It is important that ALL your child's possessions (including luggage) are marked clearly with their name – this includes towels, all clothing and shoes.

Important things to note:

Although we will be holding a parent/carer meeting, we have included some useful information below, for those who would like to make some preparations for the trip beforehand.

On Monday 2nd March, we will be leaving after registration, so <u>children will need to arrive for school at the usual school time.</u>

Upon arrival at school, children will need to neatly line up their suitcases/bags outside their classroom. They should also be labelled.

We will return on Friday 6th March

We will be leaving the Stubbington Site after lunch. When we arrive back at school, we will be coming back into the classroom for normal dismissal at the end of the school day, at 3pm. Please note that all luggage will be on the bottom playground for you to collect with your child. If you have other arrangements and will not be meeting your child, such as FWAS, please let us know in writing prior to the trip.

As it will be March, the temperature is variable and a high possibility of rain, so please ensure your children have plenty of warm and waterproof clothes.
