Dear Parents and Carers,

**YEAR 6 – MAKE £5 GROW CHALLENGE- Wednesday 17<sup>th</sup> June 2026**

As your children may have told you, we are taking part in a very exciting challenge called the ‘**Virgin Money: Make £5 Grow.**’ This will be an exciting enterprise experience and will enable the Year 6 children to establish their own business and create a product or a service. They will then be given an opportunity to sell their product/service on **Wednesday 17<sup>th</sup> June** to children across the school, with parents being invited in at the end of the day from 3pm until 3.30pm to explore the stalls and possibly gain some final ‘closing-down sale’ bargains!

The children are going to form small groups, **having very kindly been given a £5 loan each from the FSS to buy supplies for their business.** As we are going to be teaching the children budgeting and enterprise skills, please refrain from buying your children items and encourage them not to spend their own money either. Children may want to use items from home if it fits within their business model but if you could please try not to buy anything specifically for this challenge, we would greatly appreciate it. One member of each group will need to change their £5 note into coins for their float and also provide a suitable container to store the proceeds.

Any group creating food as part of their business model must avoid products containing nuts and provide a list of ingredients to support with allergies.

Any profit made (once the £5 seed money has been returned to the FSS) will be spent on Year 6 as a year group at Paulton’s park and their leavers party and will depend on how much money the teams are able to generate.
