We are very pleased to be able to offer you the opportunity to secure your child's place for the next academic year's, Year 5, brand-new Residential destination – Stubbington Study Centre. This is an exciting trip where the children will have the opportunity to spend 5 days (4 nights) with their peers; trying out lots of new and exciting activities.
